The City Council of the City of Eminence, Kentucky met in special session on Monday, May 18, 2026, at 5:30 p.m. with Mayor Fred Downey and the following members present: Lee Ann Armstrong, Bobbi Jo Frazier, Karen Paris, Phillip Smith, Justin Wayman, and Connie Nation. Also, in attendance were City Attorney Chelsey Brammell, City Clerk Robin Mullins, Police Chief Scott Wilcoxson, Sergeant Michael Corley, Detective Brett Downey and Resident Sylvia Wilcoxson.

Mayor Downey called the special meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Pledge of allegiance held.

The special meeting was called to approve the second reading of the Ethics Ordinance, Discuss a Promotion, and Salary for promotion.

Second Reading of Ethics Ordinance: Before the Second Reading could be held Member Smith asked why the entire ordinance was being repealed. Clerk Mullins stated the entire ordinance hadn't been updated since 1994 and the section on nepotism was the only part updated in 2022. A committee of an Employee, Council Member, and Member of Ethics Committee Member met with KLC's Attorney to do the ordinance in its entirety to become a certified city.

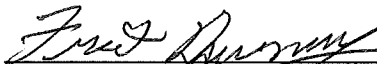
Council decided they would like to compare the old ordinance with the new ordinance to see if they were in agreement with the changes of the new ordinance.

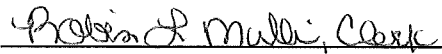
Clerk Mullins will get a copy of the old ordinance to the council members tomorrow morning.
