OLD BUSINESS:

Subject: Minutes May 13, 2024 – The minutes from May 13, 2024, were reviewed. Mayor Downey asked for any additions or corrections to the minutes. Motion made by Member Smith and seconded by Member Nation to approve the minutes as presented. On a call for votes, all members present voted, "Yea".

NEW BUSINESS:

First Reading of Budget Ordinance for Fiscal Year End 6/30/2025:

Member Paris asked if the sidewalk project was complete because of the Municipal Aid Budget for \$40,000.00. Mayor Downey reported there are still some sidewalks that need to be done.
